Howard Carter, English archaeologist, Egyptologist

### **Short bio of Carter:**

In late 1922, he and patron George Edward Stanhope Molyneux, Earl of Carnarvon discovered the tomb of King Tut in Egypt, one of the greatest archeological finds.

### **Other information about your character:**

After being steeped in the lore of ancient Egypt, you're willing to believe in the supernatural. However, since you're a man of science, you'll want to be sure to investigate thoroughly.

## **Margaret Singer - Fact Sheet**

### **Based on:**

Margaret Sanger, U.S. activist

### **Short bio of Sanger:**

She was a leader in the birth control movement. As a nurse, she observed poverty and believed contraception would help alleviate it. She won a free speech case in 1916 on the right to distribute informational materials on contraception. She started the first U.S. birth control clinic in 1916, in New York City. She was arrested for creating a public nuisance, but won the case. She organized the first World Population Conference in 1927. She founded the American Birth Control League in 1921, which later became Planned Parenthood. She first published Birth Control Review in 1928.

### **Other information about your character:**

You're a very vocal feminist, and insist on being treated as a man's equal. You don't scream at mice.
